The bidder shall submit two copies of bid and clearly mention as "ORIGINAL" and "COPY" as appropriate. In the event of discrepancy between them, the "ORIGINAL" shall prevail.

5. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.

6.
